
WHEREAS, the Switlik Dolphins proudly hosted the Governor and Cabinet for its Cabinet meeting on May 8th, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governor and Cabinet of the State of Florida do hereby express our appreciation to




